BISHOP DONALD F. HANCHON



Bishop Hanchon was born in Jackson, Michigan to John Michael and Alfreda (Glinicki) Hanchon. He was the middle of seven children and attended parochial schools until the moment he entered the former Cardinal Mooney Latin School in 1961. He is a graduate of Sacred Heart Seminary (BA, 1969), St. John's Provincial Seminary (1972) and has Master's degrees in

Theology (University of Detroit, 1972); Liturgy (University of Notre Dame, 1974); and Ministry (St. John's Provincial Seminary, 1982).

He was ordained a priest of the Archdiocese of Detroit on October 19, 1974. Since the mid 80's he has completed studies in Spanish and Hispanic Culture in Mexico and has served as a pastor in parishes serving the Hispanic community.

He was named Monsignor in 2005, and in the fall of 2009 was designated collaborator in the Central Region of the Archdiocese of Detroit and will continue to serve as Regional Moderator.

On March 22, 2011, His Holiness Pope Benedict XVI appointed him as Auxiliary Bishop for the Archdiocese of Detroit and Titular Bishop of Orreomargo.
